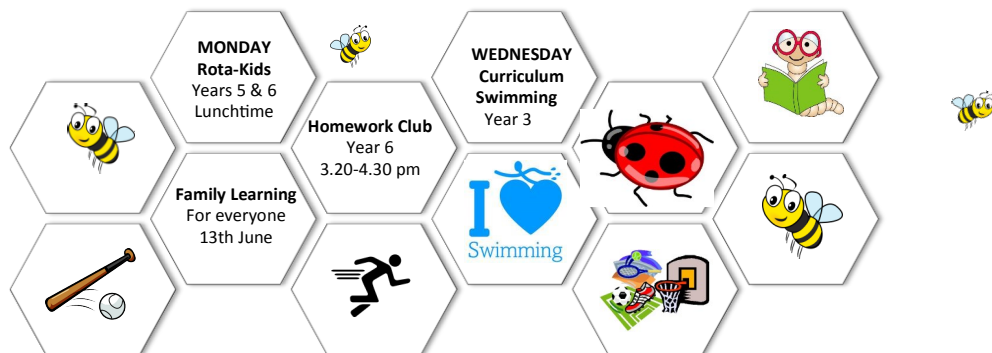

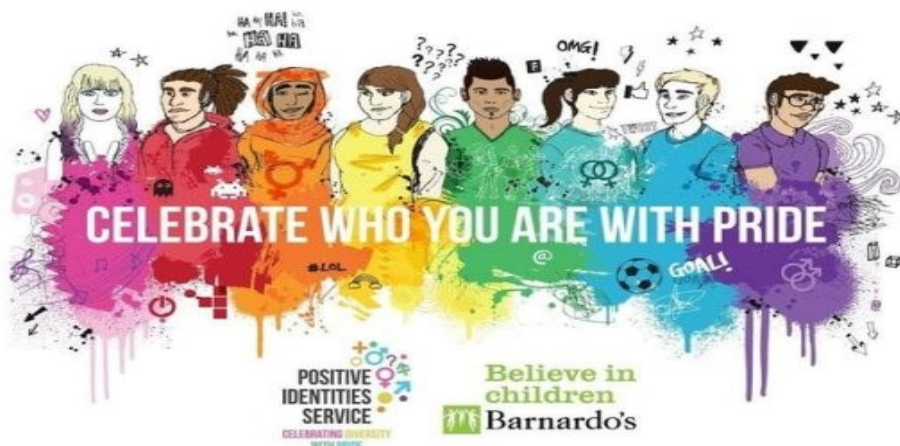
BUSY BEES - AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES & CLUBS



IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING SCHOOL TIMES AND CHILD ABSENCE

We would like to remind parents/carers that the school day starts at 9.00 am prompt. It is important that children arrive at school on time as an important part of learning is missed otherwise. Please note that if your child arrives later than 9.20 am then they lose their mark for the whole morning. If your child is going to be absent for any reason it must be reported to school as near to 9.00 am as possible or sooner if possible. Calderdale guidelines state that if a parent has not reported an absence then we **MUST** do the following:-

 - ◆ Ring contacts in priority order on data sheet
 - ◆ Text again
 - ◆ Visit home

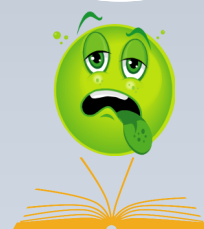
