#### CHILDREN'S RAFFLE

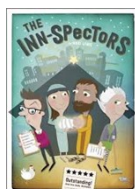
Tickets 20p each, now available from the office. Tickets will also be sold at the Christmas Fair. The draw will take place in school on our Christmas Dinner day.

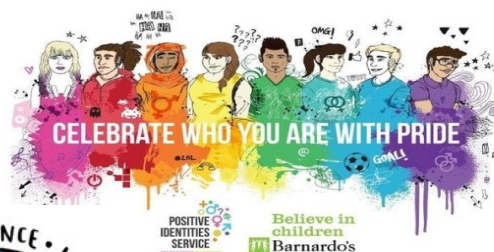
